

# Dress Code Guidelines

It is the policy of the school district to encourage students to dress appropriately for school activities and in keeping with community standards.

1. Shorts/skirts should be at finger tip length when arms are resting at your side.
2. Shirts need to cover all cleavage and midriffs.
3. Tank tops need to be worn on top of the shoulder, should have two shoulder straps and shoulder straps need to be two fingers wide.
4. All undergarments should be beneath clothing and not visible.
5. Pants should be worn at or above the waist.
6. No sweatshirt hoods should be worn inside of the school building.
7. Students should have non marking shoes for gym class.
8. Hats, sunglasses and bandanas are not to be worn unless special permission from the principal has been granted.
9. Clothing may not be worn that bears a message that is lewd, vulgar, obscene or offensive.
10. Clothing may not be worn that suggests or mentions drugs, tobacco or alcohol.

Consequences will be dealt with on a case by case basis, but the following is a guideline of consequences. Students will not be allowed back into class with dress code violations.

1. Students will be asked to change.
2. Students will be asked to change and parents will be contacted.
3. Students will be asked to change, parents will be contacted, and a before or after school focus hour will be given.
4. Students will be asked to change, the student, parent, and administration will have a disciplinary conference and students will receive an ISS along with any other consequences deemed appropriate at the conference.
