

Technology Provider Parent Communication

As defined in MN Statute 13.31 Subd 13.h, all public educational agencies must, within the first 30 days of each school year, provide a direct communication to all parents and students of any curriculum, testing, or assessment technology provider contract that affects or otherwise contains a student's educational data. The notice must address the following requirements:

- 1. Identify each curriculum, testing, or assessment technology provider with access to educational data.*
- 2. Identify the educational data that is affected by the curriculum, testing or assessment provider under contract with the school.*
- 3. Include information about the school's contract inspection process, including a description of the steps that are taken to ensure that contracts ensure the safety and integrity of student data.*
- 4. Provide contact information for a school department to which a parent or student may direct questions or concerns regarding any program or activity that allows a curriculum, testing or assessment technology provider to access a student's educational data.*
- 5. Parents and students must be provided with and opportunity to inspect a complete copy of any contract that the school has with a technology provider.*
