ADD/DROP

- Students have three days to add/drop from 1st semester/2nd semester

1 to 1 chromebooks

- Students will pick up their computer when they come, and drop it off before they leave at an assigned location.
- Students can't take home a device, we are hoping that eventually have a check out system but not at this time.
- If a student is late you have to wait until the next hr. to pick up your chromebook
- If they are leaving early and it is during a class they will drop it off at the office.

1 to 1 devices continue

- Staff will be able to monitor what is on the students browser
- If students are caught on inappropriate sites it will be considered insubordinate and consequences may be given
- Electronic devices other than the chromebook are no longer necessary in classrooms. So it will be at teacher discretion.

Edgerton Public School Cell Phone policy

- **Cell Phones are permitted at teacher discretion but should be put in the pocket charts in each room and not seen during the class hour.**
- **Consequences for improper use:**
 - **1st Offense** –warning, given back at the end of the day
 - **2nd Offense-** Staff member will confiscate phone, parents will be contacted and a before or after school focus hour will be given. Parents must retrieve their child's phone.
 - **3rd Offense** –ISS and any other consequences deemed appropriate at the conference.
- **Students will need to go to the office to retrieve their phone.**
- **Attempts to refuse to turn over the device will be considered insubordination and subject to further disciplinary action.**

Social Media at school

- Any use of social media during school hours that may be viewed as detrimental will be considered insubordination and student will be subject to consequences as outlined in our school handbook under Student conduct and Discipline.

Earning Credits

- To receive 1 credit in a full year course, students in grades 7-12 must successfully complete both semesters. The semester(s) that was/were failed must be repeated at a passing level in order to earn 1 full credit. Semester credit will be weighed as follows 40% per quarter and 20% for the final for grades 9-12. Grades 7-8 will be 45%/quarter and 10% final
- Plato classes are for pass/fail only; unless prior approval granted.
